DURHAM, NC MAY 12 & 13, 2017

Format: The championship will be an Open format, 4 event, 3 game guarantee event. The Curling Club of Virginia will be our hosts. The venue is the Triangle Curling Club, 2310 So-Hi Drive, Durham, NC 27703. The club is located about ten miles from the Raleigh-Durham International Airport.

Cost: \$400 per rink. Entry fee includes all meals, including continental breakfasts, lunches, and Friday and Saturday dinners. Alcohol and soft drinks will be available for purchase.

Eligibility: Participants must be dues paying members of the GNCC for 2017-2018 and be eligible according to the attached GNCC Rules for the event, with at least two exclusive Arena ice curlers (do not play regularly in any leagues on dedicated curling ice).

Teams: The event will be limited to 20 teams. Each Arena Club in the GNCC is guaranteed a spot for at least one team as long as entries are received by April 9. Clubs may and are encouraged to enter more than one team. Additional teams will be accepted on a space available basis.

Schedule: Play will start in the morning or early afternoon on **Friday, May 12**. The schedule will be determined by the number of teams that enter.

- Registration will close on **April 16th** so that we can make the draw and let everyone know when their first game is.

- Finalists will be piped out onto the ice for an exciting Saturday night final, with award presentations immediately following the games.
